In the case of a serious injury, such as brain or spinal cord injury, a severe orthopedic injury, an amputation or a burn, children require support from a CCLS who has extensive training and experience in the developmental impact of injury, as well as working closely with other members of the child's medical and rehab team.

NRS CCLS assessments and treatment are offered in the hospital, home and school, as well as at our clinic. We also offer virtual services.

Working closely with the child's family, medical and rehabilitation team, caregivers/teachers, as well as the insurer and legal representative, our experienced CCLSs provide:

- Evidence based, developmentally and psychologically appropriate interventions including therapeutic play, preparations for procedures and education to reduce fear, anxiety and pain.
